the first Sunday of every October,
that promotes Christian unity
and ecumenical cooperation.

The Pastor's Peace

The tradition was begun in 1933 by Hugh Thomson Kerr who ministered in the Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. It was then adopted throughout the Presbyterian Church (USA) in 1936 and subsequently spread to other denominations. In 1940, the Federal Council of Churches (now the National Council of Churches), led by Jesse Moren Bader, endorsed World Communion Sunday and began to promote it to Christian churches worldwide.

We find ourselves in 2025 celebrating ecumenical partnership with two local congregations. This year we will worship together with St. John's United Church of Christ and Hope Lutheran Church. The worship service will begin at 10:00 AM AT 2010 Park Avenue West and will consist of leadership from all three congregations. Following the service, we will join together for a shared meal in Hope's fellowship hall.

At 1:00 pm members from all three churches will join with more Richland County neighbors to participate in this year's CROP Walk. The walk will begin and end at the Jericho Wall and we will be making our fellowship hall and restrooms available to those who are part of this event.

I truly hope you will join us for both the combined worship service at Hope Lutheran as well as the CROP Walk this year. I am grateful that in 1933 someone had the vision to bring denominations together to recognize that we find unity at the Lord's Table. Since then there have been wonderful ecumenical endeavors to show that we hold much more in common with one another than the differences we allow to divide us from each other.

Our tradition as the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) began with a desire to gather together God's people, to seek unity as a polar star, and to welcome all to God's Table. May we faithful Disciples here in Mansfield continue on with that noble and very needed mission today.


